

Resolution No. 2021-23

A RESOLUTION OF SEWARD COUNTY, KANSAS TO EXCEED THE REVENUE NEUTRAL RATE IN ITS PROPERTY TAX LEVY FOR THE TAX YEAR OF 2022.

WHEREAS, the Seward County Board of County Commissioners is statutorily required to provide notice and hearing prior to exceeding the Revenue Neutral Rate; and

WHEREAS, Seward County provided notice of the hearing on the Revenue Neutral Rate on August 31, 2021 and

WHEREAS, the Revenue Neutral Rate for tax year 2022 for Seward County was calculated as 48.002 mills by the County Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the budget proposed by the Seward County Board of County Commissioners for tax year 2022 will require the levy of a property tax rate exceeding the Revenue Neutral Rate; and

WHEREAS, the Seward County Board of County Commissioners held a hearing on September 10, 2021 allowing all interested taxpayers an opportunity to be heard at the hearing; and

WHEREAS, the Seward County Board of County Commissioners having heard testimony, have determined that it is in the best interests of Seward County to exceed the Revenue Neutral Rate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SEWARD COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS:

Seward County shall levy a property tax rate exceeding the Revenue Neutral Rate for Tax Year 2022.

This resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and shall remain in effect until future action is taken by the Seward County Board of County Commissioners.
