

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-19

RESOLUTION TO APPROVE PROPOSED EXTENSION DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Seward County, Kansas, is authorized to approve an agreement pertaining to proposed extension districts created under K.S.A. 2-623, et. seq.; and,

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Seward County Extension Council to join the Haskell and Stevens County Extension Councils in forming an extension district pursuant to K.S.A. 2-623; and, it is the intent of the Seward County Commissioners to form a district with any of these counties that complete the requirements for forming the district; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to K.S.A. 2-623(i) prior to approving the agreement of the proposed extension district, the Board of County Commissioners of Seward County, Kansas, is required to provide certain notice.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Seward County, Kansas, that it is the intention of the Board of County Commissioners of Seward County, Kansas, to approve an agreement to permit the Seward County Extension Council to join the Haskell and Stevens County Extension Councils in forming an extension district pursuant to K.S.A. 2-623, et seq.; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the extension district shall have for its sole purpose the giving of instruction and practical demonstration in agriculture, marketing, home economics (family and consumer sciences), 4-H Club and youth work, community and resource development, and economic development initiatives to all persons in the extension district and the imparting of such persons of information on the subjects through practical demonstrations, meetings, publications, or otherwise in accordance with the program and service prescribed by the governing body of the extension district; and,

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that if, within sixty (60) days following the last publication of this resolution, a petition in opposition to the approval of the agreement and the inclusion of Seward County in the extension district is signed by not less than five percent (5%) of the qualified electors of Seward County and is filed with the Seward County election officer, the Board of County Commissioners of Seward County, Kansas, will not approve the agreement and Seward County will not be included in the Extension district unless and until the agreement is approved by a majority of the qualified electors of Seward County voting at a primary or a general election or a special election called and held for such purpose. This resolution shall become effective the day and year below written.
