

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-11

**A RESOLUTION CREATING A SPECIAL REVENUE FUND FOR THE CARES ACT,
CORONAVIRUS RELIEF FUNDS (CRF)**

WHEREAS, on July 1, 2020 through resolution 2020-10 the Board of County Commissioners of Seward County, Kansas accepted \$6,419,281.00 in funds appropriated to the County by the State of Kansas through the State's Coronavirus Relief Fund ("herein "CRF funds") pursuant to the terms designed to ensure the lawful use of funds and transparency, equity, and accountability; and

WHEREAS, the CRF funds have yet to be received by the County from the State but are anticipated to be received in the near future; and

WHEREAS, Seward County is advised that it should create a special revenue fund in which to place those funds.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SEWARD COUNTY, KANSAS, that:

Section 1. Creation of Special Revenue Fund. A Special Revenue Fund called CARES ACT, CRF FUNDS is hereby created in which to place CRF funds received from the State of Kansas.


Section 2. Publication. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its publication once in the official county newspaper.
