

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-11

**A RESOLUTION REPEALING CERTAIN PREVIOUSLY ENACTED RESOLUTIONS
MADE DURING LOCAL PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, on the 16th day of March, 2020, the Board of County Commissioners of Seward County, Kansas through Resolution 2020-03 declared there was a continuing state of local public health emergency in Seward County, Kansas resulting in a potential or occurring Pandemic known as Covid-19 in Seward County, Kansas for a period of 60 days;

WHEREAS, the state of local public health emergency and disaster in Seward County, Kansas originally declared on the 16th day of March, 2020 has been extended by subsequent resolutions until December 31, 2021;

WHEREAS, to minimize the impact of the pandemic, the Board previously passed resolutions 2020-15, 2020-24, and 2021-02 which dealt with restricting access to county buildings and limiting gatherings within the county;

WHEREAS, since the declaration of local public health emergency there has been improvement in the county situation involving Covid-19; and

WHEREAS, it is not necessary at this time to continue to have in place the foregoing resolutions restricting access to county buildings or limiting gatherings.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SEWARD COUNTY, KANSAS, adopt the following:

Section 1. Repeal of Certain Covid-19 Related Resolutions. Seward County Resolutions 2020-15, 2020-24, and 2021-02, are hereby repealed in their entirety and are no longer of any force and effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED this resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon adoption. All provisions herein shall remain in effect until March 8, 2021.
