

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-26

**A RESOLUTION COMMENCING PROCEEDINGS TO VACATE A PORTION OF A
SEWARD COUNTY ROAD "G" AND GIVING NOTICE OF A PUBLIC HEARING
HEREON**

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Seward County, Kansas (hereinafter "the Board") is the governing body of Seward County, Kansas (hereinafter "the County"), and is charged with the responsibility of determining whether roads within the County should be laid out, altered or vacated, pursuant to K.S.A. 68-102 *et seq.*; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that a portion of Seward County Road "G" which is located in the County, as described more fully herein, is not a public utility by reason of neglect, nonuse, or inconvenience or from other cause or causes such road has become practically impassable and he necessity for such road as a public utility does not justify the expenditure of the necessary funds to repair such road or put the same in condition for public travel; and

WHEREAS, the Board desires to vacate certain portions of Road "G."

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY
COMMISSIONERS OF SEWARD COUNTY KANSAS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. That the Board has determined that the following portions of Seward County Road "G" should be vacated, as contemplated by K.S.A. 68-102 (b):

A portion of a road Seward County, Kansas Road "G", being more particularly described as follows:

That portion of Seward County Road "G" in the Southeast Quarter (SE/4) of Section Twelve (12), Township Thirty-Five (35) South, Range Thirty-Four (34) West and in the Southwest Quarter (SW/4) of Section Seven (7), Township Thirty-Five (35) South, Range Thirty-Three (33) West, all of which solely lies south of (and is bound by) the south right-of-way of that road commonly referred to as Old Highway 54 and north of (and is bound by) the north right-of-way of United State Highway 54 all in in Seward County, Kansas.


2. That a public hearing shall be scheduled for the purpose of determining whether the above described road should be vacated. Said hearing shall be held in the Commission Chambers of Seward County Courthouse, Liberal, Kansas, on November 1, 2021 at 5:30 p.m.
3. That any person wishing to appear at the aforementioned hearing and give evidence or testimony thereon may do so.
4. That at the conclusion of the aforementioned hearing, the Board shall determine what road or

part of the road described herein is to vacated.

5. That the County Clerk shall send a copy of this Resolution by certified mail to each owner of property adjoining the above described road, at the address where the owner's tax statement is sent.
6. That this Resolution shall be published once in the official County newspaper,


